- 376. **Heavy Goods Vehicles in the Parish** The Chair and County Cllr Jackson had met at the school and Cllr Jackson had attended meetings with Bardon Aggregates and County Planning at derby Dale to ask for lorries to be stopped driving through parishes at school start and end times. Cllr Foster felt there were more HGV's since contractors had taken over Vigelia. Cllr Waite felt that since Vigelia's demise more vehicles are going up Cromford Hill and turning right out of the quarry. Cllr Jackson would be visiting the quarry on Friday. The chair thanked Cllr Jackson for his support. Agenda item for the January meeting.

- 383. **Street Light on house Leas View Upper Lea – RESOLVED** the Clerk was to have a site meeting with Chris Green from Derbyshire County Council street lighting and then report back to the Parish Council.

RESOLVED the Cllrs agreed that the Clerk was to write to ask if the Dethick Lea & Holloway Parish could be removed from East Derbyshire district and added to the Derbyshire Dales District as the Parish was more Derbyshire Dales District than East Derbyshire as the Derbyshire Dales starts at Lea Bridge and the Parish is geographically Derbyshire Dales. Cllrs agreed that at the Annual Parish Meeting a Derbyshire Dales spokesperson should be invited to speak.
387. **Cemetery Grave Purchases Procedure** RESOLVED the Clerk and Cllr Foster had met at the cemetery and explained issues that had arisen regarding procedures of grave purchasing and numbering and the role of the Funeral Directors. Cllr Foster was to draft a letter and the Clerk with the Chair would send a letter to all Funeral Directors, also the Clerk is to send a letter to the Bartlett family apologising for any distress and a letter to the other family involved.
