

Remembrance Day

The Royal British Legion advises the Parish Council that it would not be able to provide new lamp post poppies this year due to the Coronavirus pandemic but asked us to reuse those from previous years if at all possible and then to make a donation to their funds.

The Parish Council has agreed to do this, along with purchasing the wreath for the remembrance service in the church and has therefore donated. We have managed to find some of the poppies and you will see a team of people putting these on lamp posts around the parish over the next week or so to commemorate the British and Commonwealth Armed Forces.

When we initially used the poppies, we asked our residents to sponsor a poppy, which you did very generously, and then the Parish Council added a donation on top. As we will be unable to make a collection this time, we would like to ask you to donate into the collection box for the individual poppies, which will still be available in the village shop.
