Whilst the Lea Road scheme has been closed for works for some time, we are pleased to announce we are re-opening the site.

Due to the complexity of the engineering challenges a new design has been developed changing from a piling solution to a rock revetment and works have recommenced on 21st March. We have agreed a programme of works and the revised completion date is November 2022.

We thank you for your ongoing patience with this scheme and remain committed to keeping you informed and delivering this complex, but important project.

Current/Ongoing traffic restrictions and closures

Lea Road will remain closed to all vehicle's including cyclist and pedestrians until the project is complete.
