

# Leashaw landslip update

We wanted to give you all an update as to where we are with reopening Leashaw on one side of the road. We met with representatives from the local Parish Council and County Councillor Taylor a few weeks ago on site to discuss the current situation, so we wanted to provide a summary of the current situation.

We're currently carrying out a road safety audit into the one sided carriageway reopening proposals and this is looking at whether this should be traffic light managed or give way. We are also looking at suitable barriers for the road which would protect the reopened carriageway area from the slip area.

Unfortunately, since Storm Babet, we have found that the road is still showing signs of movement. Our engineers are carefully monitoring the site, including looking at the water tables, bore holes and the physical movement of the road. We do need to continue with this evaluation before we can confirm if we are able to safely go ahead and open up one side of the road. Due to the nature of the slip and damage, the widths for reopening are restricted, so any further movement could prohibit this.

We'd hope to know more by early December, and will continue to keep everyone informed as to progress.

We do appreciate that the road being closed is causing considerable issues for local businesses and residents and would like to reassure everyone that we are doing all we can to reopen the road as soon as we feel it is safe to do so.
