Movement of Lea Road – upcoming road closure for temporary work


As you may have noticed, Lea Road, close to the site of the previous landslip, is unfortunately showing some signs of movement.

We are planning to close the road on Sunday 21 April so that we can make some temporary repairs and do some further investigative work.

We realise that this closure will cause some inconvenience, and we apologise for this. We've planned it for a Sunday outside of half-term to try to minimise any disruption. The road is quite narrow at this point, so we need to close the whole road to do the work.

In the run up to this work we have put some temporary traffic lights on the road, installed yesterday to allow some investigation works over the next few weeks too. It is planned for these to be removed after the work is done, on the 22nd April.

We wanted to give residents and stakeholders advance warning of these works and this closure, but it will be weather dependent so we will update you if there are any changes. Site notices and signage will also be going up soon.
